

## Santos Southern Australia Fields

Increasing asset productivity



Santos has been supplying natural gas to Australia for more than 40 years, and today is one of the largest producers of gas for the domestic market. In 2011, Santos has a market capitalisation in excess of \$10 billion, with new investments in LNG across Australia and Asia.

#### **ANALYSIS**

Renoir was invited to identify efficiency improvement opportunities in the production and maintenance operation of Santos' field assets in South Australia, including planning, scheduling, contractor management, and role of site leadership. Renoir's Analysis identified savings opportunities in a range of \$4.6-8.5M, achievable without additional capital investment by focusing on opportunities to increase tool time of Santos staff and contractors by 12-20% through:

- · Removal of non value adding administration.
- Improvement of planning and material management processes.
- Standardised grading.
- Implementation of short interval controls.
- Enabling site management to hold staff accountable.

Critically, the proposal gained approval and commitment from senior Santos management, which helped ensure the success of the Project. Divided into 4 stages over 48 weeks, the Project included:

- · Definition and quantification.
- Solution development.
- · Installation of solutions.
- Auditing and aftercare.

## **Key Results**

Annual cost reduction of \$5.2M through efficiency increases

Increase in maintenance tradesmen tool time of 25%

Increase in production operators working time of 13%

Reduction in reliance on contrac-tors to complete services

## **PROJECT APPROACH**

During the first 17 weeks of the Project, Renoir's Project Team, consisting of both Renoir and Santos staff, carried out detailed studies and developed new systems and processes that would address the issues as part of Renoir's Focus Process<sup>®</sup>. Key findings included:

- Excessive time with non value adding activities.
- Ineffective contractor management.
- Excessive administrative activities reduced active supervision.
- · Inaccurate job time estimates.
- · Lack of formal operator job planning.
- Bills of Materials routinely missing or inaccurate.
- · Lack of confidence in job planning improvement process.
- · KPIs not driving positive behavior.
- Poor budget visibility to Supervisors/Superintendents.
- Poor co-ordination between trades.


